Energy Conservation Policy

- It is the Company's policy to reduce energy consumption, thus conserving finite hydrocarbon resources and, reducing operational costs and environmental impacts.
- This policy applies to all aspects of ship operation and includes all technical, operational and organizational personnel. All shore staff and crew members should endeavour to contribute to improving our energy efficiency on a continual basis.
- The Company commits to comply with all relevant national and international rules and regulations, and other requirements to which the Company subscribes.
- Contractors and others working on behalf of the Company are encouraged to consider energy efficiency when working on board managed vessels.
- A framework for the setting of energy objectives and performance targets has been developed, and objectives and targets are regularly monitored and reviewed. Performance results are communicated internally, and externally where appropriate.
- The energy consumption across all sections of the Company is closely monitored, analysed and documented.
- When purchasing goods and services, the Company evaluates the opportunities for improving energy efficiency and considers this as part of the selection criteria where appropriate and practicable to do so.
- The Company supports its Principals in the consideration of energy efficiency during the purchase of, and modification or retrofit as may be appropriate for, their vessels.
- Energy performance improvement is supported through technical, operational and organisational matters by:
 - 1. Setting objectives and targets for energy performance improvement
 - 2. Raising awareness and providing training on energy efficiency
 - 3. Provision of ship specific energy efficiency management plans for every ship and energy action plans for performance improvement
 - 4. Empowering all crew to be able to suggest ideas for energy saving
 - 5. Developing a positive culture of energy awareness and conservation
 - 6. Accurate and timely reporting of energy & environmental performance data and the retention of appropriate records
 - 7. Partnering with Universities and Research Organisations in order to develop new and innovative ways of making our operations more energy efficient
- The Company commits to the provision of adequate resources to achieve compliance with this policy.
